## Got Your Brown Bin?

The brown bins have recently been delivered on the territory of the Municipality of Frelighsburg. We invite you to **read the instructions inside the bin.**

No plastic bags – even compostable or biodegradable – will be accepted in the brown bin; only paper bags.

**I'm already composting. Why use brown bins?** The brown bins should be seen as a supplement to backyard or household composting. Experience shows that domestic composting is not practiced by all citizens and therefore does not reprocesses the entire organic matter produced by each household. For example, meat, fish, fatty and sweet products, paper and cardboard stained with food, or weed seeds cannot go in a home composting system. Practice demonstrates that a home composting household still puts 1.5 to 2.5 kg of organic matter in the brown bin every week ... that's 100 kg per year! It adds up to a ton of matter reprocessed and not going to the landfill every year for only a dozen households! Not to mention that in winter, it's easier to reach for the brown bin than walk to the

composter at the back of the yard. To this day, door-to-door collection using brown bins remains the only way to reprocess ALL organic matter. Watch for the new collection schedule starting this October!

## Waste material collection instructions

- All wheeled bins must be placed on the side of the road with the cover opening facing the road. Take out your bins in the evening of the day before collection.

- A distance of one metre (40 inches) must be kept between a bin and cars, other bins, trees, mailboxes, etc. Do not put the bin on the sidewalk, but rather at the edge of the street less than 2.4 m (8 feet) from the sidewalk.

- Only use blue bins for recyclable materials. **Any garbage placed in blue bins will not be picked up.** Do not put garbage or recyclables on the top of a closed bin or next to a bin.

- Cardboard must be cut into pieces of 3' x 3' maximum.
