Brown Bins

Composting collection (brown bins) is scheduled to begin the week after Thanksgiving (October 15th). The blue bins and the brown bins will then be picked up alternately every 2 weeks. The week of October 1st will be the last weekly collection of the green bins (garbage). Afterwards, they will be picked up once a month.

Full information will be sent to all citizens of Frelighsburg in early October.

Go With the Flow

In September of 2018, students from grade 3 to 6 at École Saint-François-d'Assise continued their scientific research begun in the spring with experts from the École-o-village organization to assess water quality of the Pike River.

They identified a number of benthic macro-invertebrates that are highly sensitive to water pollution, including the water boatman, a hemiptera, and the giant pearl, a plecoptera. Water temperature was 23°C and pH was neutral. Many trees and shrubs on the riverbanks help keep the river healthy. Again, bio-indicators show a water quality of 8 to 9 out of 10.
