Sound Advice From Your Fire Department – Sweep at Least Once a Year!

An average of 1,200 chimney fires occur every year in Quebec. It is recommended to have your chimney swept by a professional every

spring. Before lighting up for the first time in the fall, check your chimney with a small mirror to ensure no obstructions were created during the summer (bird nests, debris, etc.)

What to do with dead leaves?

You have five composting options:

1. Use them in your composter or offer them to a neighbour who composts.
2. Leafcycle, consisting in mowing and leaving the shredded leaves on the ground to naturally compost.
3. Bring them for FREE (paper bags only or in bulk) to one of the area's Ecocentres (see schedule at bmvert.ca)
4. Bring them for FREE on weekdays during the fall at the Régie's composting platform located at 2500 Rang St-Joseph in Cowansville (paper bags only or in bulk).
5. Bring your leaves to the drop-off at the Municipal Park on Richford road from mid-October to mid-November (paper bags only).
