### Snow Removal and Waste Materials Collection

In order not to interfere with snow clearing operations and ensure proper collection of your waste materials while protecting your roll-out containers, you must put these on the edge of your driveway and not on sidewalks or public roads. It is prohibited to take them out more

than 24 hours before collection time. Ideally, take out your containers by 7 pm the day before and remove them as soon as possible after collection.

### Winter Overnight Parking

According to By-law 330-2010 regarding traffic and parking, it is prohibited to park a vehicle on a public road located on the territory of the Municipality between 11 pm and 7 am from November 15th to March 31st. The Sûreté du Québec is responsible for enforcing this By-law. Additionally, you are required at all times to ensure that no parked vehicles interfere with sidewalk clearing operations.
